

Siglo Humidor - Individually Handcrafted

Each Siglo humidor is made of 100% genuine Spanish cedarwood. Since wood bleeding is natural for cedarwood, so does that of Siglo humidor. In case of any occurrence of the event, please pat alcohol onto the affected areas and let it air-dry gradually at room temperature, and the humidor will regain its natural color, offering optimal condition for cigars storage.

The exterior of Siglo humidor is individually handcrafted. Each piece is unique and slight variations in colors and wood patterns are signs of craftsmanship and natural beauty.





Our Guarantee

Every Siglo humidor you buy is guaranteed of its quality. We took great pride in ensuring that the Siglo humidor is airtight and the inside veneer of the humidor is made of Spanish cedar. Cigars stored in Spanish cedar humidor give the cigars the same scent it would have in its original cigar packaging or box.

Warranty

In the unlikely case of finding a defect with one of our humidor, please notify the shop staff immediately. The Siglo humidor offers I year warranty to any mechanical and construction defect due to manufacturing fault from date of purchase at no charge. However, you must pay for the postage to send your humidor to the Siglo factory for service.

The Siglo warranty for humidor covers mechanism and construction only and exclude any damage resulting from accident, misuse, tampering or abuse. The outer finish of this humidor is not covered under this warranty. In order to preserve the aesthetics of the outer finish, please do not put any

objects such as coins or keys on top of your humidor.





Repair Service

If you like us to repair your Siglo humidor due to accident, misuse, tampering or abuse, please send your repair request to us by fax: (852) 2520 6528 together with your purchase receipt, contact number, email and mailing address, to get a return authorization from the Siglo factory before you return your humidor to us.

Once you obtain a return authorization from the Siglo factory, please package your humidor well so that it will not be damaged during the transition.

Upon receipt of your humidor, the Siglo factory will contact you with the repair charge to get your repair authorization.



Please note that the Siglo factory will not be responsible for lost, late, damaged, misdirected or postage-due mail.

How to prepare your humidor

I) Verify if the relative moisture the analog hygrometer shows is correct (between 65% to 72%). If you have to re-calibrate your analog hygrometer, put it inside a moist towel for 30 minutes. If the calibration of your analog hygrometer is correct, it should read between 98% to 100%.




- Otherwise, apply the difference to your future reading of your analog hygrometer.
- 2) Moisten the interior walls lightly with distilled water in order to return the natural moisture to the wood.
- 3) Take a little container with distilled water (the same size as a cup of coffee) or place a damp sponge in a container and let it inside the empty humidor. Closed the humidor and leave it for a week.
- 4) After that, remove the container or sponge and put distilled water or humidifier liquid into the humidifier. Shake the humidifier and clean off excess water to avoid staining the wood. Lastly, attach the humidifier onto the interior of the humidor.

How to maintain your cigars

- I) The ideal relative humidity for storing cigar is 70% that gives the cigar a regular combustion, easy draw and smoke is blueish & light. But one must also take into consideration the exterior condition of the humidor, i.e. the temperature of the room and the changes in climate. Therefore, the best way to determine how well the cigars are maintained is to smoke or feel it.
- 2) When relative humidity runs past 85%, mold appears. Beyond 90%, cigars will rot away after a few weeks or days.
- 3) When the relative humidity inside the humidor falls below the range of 65% to 72%, please refill the humidifier with distilled water or humidifier liquid.




4)During the summer season when the humidity is high, you may need to leave the humidor open and not put water into the humidifier if the reading shows higher than 72%.



- 5) In addition to relative humidity, please make sure that your humidor is kept in the temperature range of 18 degree Celsius to 22 degree Celsius.
- 6) If the humidity and temperature of your humidor move above this range (65% 72%, 18 degree Celsius 22 degree Celsius), tobacco beetles which exist in larvae form inside the leaves can hatch. The tobacco beetle can destroy every cigar in your humidor. The evidence of a beetle infestation is in the neat, circular pinhole you can find in your cigar.

- 7) If this occurs, put all the infested cigars into a sealed plastic bag and keep it in the freezer for 72 hours to kill the tobacco beetle & the larvae.
- 8) After 72 hours of freezing, move the cigars to the refrigerator for I day and then, to your humidor in order to protect your cigars from the shock of sudden temperature change.
- 9) Before you put the cigars back to your humidor, do clean the interior of the humidor with a paper or cotton towel wetted with distilled water.
